DRUG INFORMATION: Apoquel® also known as oclacitinib tablet

Why is this prescribed for your pet?

This medication is prescribed to control atopic dermatitis and pruritus associated with allergic dermatitis in dogs at least 12 months old.

Storage:

This medication should be stored between 68°-77° F. Keep this drug out of reach of children and other household pets.

How to use this medication:

- Apoquel is administered orally, twice daily for up to 14 days, and then once daily for maintenance therapy. The medication is administered according to the chart below, and may be administered with or without food.

- Some side effects that may be experienced by dogs taking this medication are: diarrhea, vomiting, anorexia, new cutaneous or subcutaneous lump, and lethargy. Most side effects resolve with continued dosing.

Additional Information:

- This medication is not for use in dogs less than 1 year old.
- This medication is not for use in dogs with serious infections.
- This medication may increase susceptibility to infection, including demodicosis. It may also exacerbate neoplastic conditions.
- Do not use this medication in breeding, pregnant, or lactating dogs.
- The safe use of this medication has not been evaluated in combination with glucocorticoids, cyclosporine, or other systemic immunosuppressive agents.
- Dogs receiving this medication should be monitored for infections.
